Report:

A Blood Donation Camp and Inauguration of Kala Sadhana Arts and Charitable Centre were organised by the Institutional Social Responsibility Club of SFIMAR – Abhimaan Club- on the occasion of Founder's Day . in commemoration of the Founder Rev. Bro. Paulus Maritz and in collaboration with BDBA Municipal General Hospital on 18th November 2021

The event created a sense of social responsibility within students. They realised that the Blood you Donate Gives Someone Another Chance at Life. They learned that blood donation is safe, simple and a satisfying experience

Prior to the event, on 15th November 2021, via an online session, Dr. Jadhav from BDBA Hospital spoke to students and cleared any myths and inhibitions about blood donation. On 18th Nov-21 the BDBA Hospital representatives created the required set-up in SFIMAR Assembly Hall and donation commenced at 11 p.m. after the speeches of dignitaries invited to inaugurate the event. Inspector Ajit Kumar Vartak and Dr. Raies Khan were the Chief Guest and Guest of Honour of the event. The dignitaries motivated the audience to donate blood and shared their experience of selflessly working for the society. They expressed their gratitude to the St. Franciscan Congregation and their activities in the field of Education that has changed the lives of numerous underprivileged children. Students, faculty members, staff members of the organization donated blood. Several local people and students from sister institutes also participated in the program. The blood donation program lasted till 3pm.

Parallely, the dignitaries inaugurated the Kala Sadhana Arts and Charitable Centre. The Centre is established with an objective to serve the needy. The Centre donated snacks and education material to 100 needy children. It plans to launch free computer classes, drawing and painting classes for the needy children and also tailoring classes for underprivileged girls and women.
