one's career. This was the primary motive for organizing the Malay event, and the club is trying to come up with many more.





All the groups were judged on parameters like interpretation and clarity of theme, quality of artistic composition and overall crib, the overall impression of art, creativity and originality of theme.


The list of winners was declared on the same day. The event was a success. It is rightly said that "Efficient team-working can transform the workplace." This was the primary motive for organizing the Malay event.

The event was a great success. It is rightly said that "an ounce of performance is worth pounds of promises." This was the primary motive for organizing the Malay event.



It is harder to recycle plastic bottles than you think. Of the mass number of plastic bottles consumed worldwide, most are not recycled because certain municipalities can recycle only certain types of plastic bottles. They either end up lying stagnant in landfills, leaching dangerous chemicals into the ground, or they infiltrate our streets as litter. They are found on sidewalks, in parks, front yards and rivers, and even if you chop them into tiny pieces, they still take more than a human lifetime to decompose.

This year, the coordinators of Malay Club decided to organize a "Best Out of Waste" (plastic bottles) competition cum exhibition on 5th October 2018. This event was conducted to inculcate team spirit among each group taking part, see how well the students coordinate and come up with new, innovative and creative ideas within one hour. 20 groups participated in this competition. The only criteria for the students were that they could use any material, but the maximum usage of plastic bottles should be seen. 

MALAY CLUB- "ART OF RANGOLI"


